Statement	STSTB follows Eligibility policies, practices and procedures when assigning students to stops on routes. When requests are received for pick up and/or drop off at an address different from a child's home address, the following shall serve as the protocol in processing such requests.	
	Alternate address requests will only be considered if the address is a caregiver's residence, or the operating address of a daycare. (See below for joint custody transportation) Transportation will not be provided to parent, guardian or student places of employment or any other places of business not operating as a licensed daycare, nor will alternate address transportation be provided for accessing student jobs or extracurricular activities. When the address of the student's caregiver or daycare falls within the school zone, STSTB will consider that address the primary address and grant transportation only if all other eligibility criteria are met.	
Practice	 Transportation will be set up on a permanent basis for the school year from the caregiver or daycare address. Parents may request a pickup from one address (ie. home) and drop off at another address in the p.m. (ie. caregiver) as long as both addresses are in zone and only if the schedule remains static throughout the school year. 	
	 Joint Custody Alternate Address For joint custody of elementary school students (see STS-ELG-004 Joint Custody Transportation), an in zone alternate address in addition to their primary address may be requested for the a.m. pick up only.
