

Statement	STSTB recognizes there are specific or exceptional situations in which ineligible students may be granted transportation as a courtesy. Granting courtesy transportation is done on an individual case basis.
Practice	The following are conditions that must be met before granting courtesy transportation to ineligible students: • there must be room on the bus • the student must be zoned for the school • the student is expected to be able to get to and from an existing stop safely Additionally, exceptions to the above conditions may be granted and a new stop added if: • there are unique or special circumstances such as medical or special needs • there are physical hazards in getting to and from an existing stop • directed by the school board During the school year, courtesy transportation may be withdrawn at any time for any of the following reasons: • seating is required for eligible students • altering the route is necessary • student behavior is unacceptable
