Statement	<p>STSTB recognizes that, under some circumstances children that are eligible for transportation may be injured and for various reasons are not able to ride a school bus. The following is the general protocol for requests for alternate transportation service (ie. taxi) for injuries of this nature.</p>
Practice	<p>STSTB does not provide alternate transportation service (ie. taxi) to students who cannot use their regular bus service due to an injury that resulted in having to wear a cast.</p> <p>However, in some instances where parents that may have mitigating circumstances wherein they cannot provide transportation to school, application may be sent to a senior Board Official for consideration.</p> <p>STSTB abides by the Board’s direction in providing taxi service to students for orthopedic transportation.</p> <p>If a student is not an eligible bus rider but is able to board and disembark a bus without assistance, STSTB may allow the student to ride temporarily as a Courtesy Rider.</p>
