Statement	Student safety is of paramount importance to STSTB. In the event that route modifications need to be made due to road or street construction, that may prevent a child from being picked up or dropped off at their regular bus stop, the following practice is in place.	
Practice	Road and street closures due to construction will be identified by STSTB and/or School Bus Operators.	
	Appropriate City Departments and/or Construction companies will be contacted for information. STSTB along with the school bus Operator will then examine the affected school bus routes and make the appropriate modifications.	
	The route that students take to and from school may experience some changes during this road closure period. Pick-up and drop- off times may be adjusted.	
	We will be communicating time changes to the parents	
	Students will be assigned a place of safety to wait for the bus for the duration of the closure.	
	In the event that STSTB or the Bus Company was not notified of a street closure and the bus is in transit the driver will radio into dispatch to notify them they are unable to pick up or drop off students at their designated stop. A place of safety will be designated for the students and parents will be contacted regarding the change.
